7th Grade Math

[Mon – Fri (4th period 10:42 – 11:27)]

Instructional Goals

At the end of this course, you will:

- Learn about using integers and absolute value with the operations of math and applying it to a coordinate plane.
- Using rational numbers with math operations, solving single and multistep equations.
- Writing and solving proportions, understanding ratios, rates and slope.
- Understand how to work with the percent equation, calculating percent of increase and decrease. Learn how to calculate discounts, markups and simple interest.
- Understand and practice surface area and volumes of various geometric shapes.
- Solve simple, multistep and equations with the variable on both sides. Introduction to slope of a line and linear functions.
- Classify angles and triangles, calculate the missing angles and sides of triangles, and work with parallel lines and transversals.
- Finding, estimating and simplifying square roots, and learn to use the Pythagorean Theorem.
- Understand exponents, zero and negative exponents. Read and write scientific notation.

- 1” inch binder with three index tabs

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

General Rules:

- All students will be expected to be to class on time with all required materials.
- All students will be respectful to the teacher and other students by listening carefully and allowing their other classmates to work in the proper environment for learning.
- Assignments must be totally finished before they are graded each morning.
- All papers must be labeled correctly to receive full credit.
- Students will be given a **grade printout** that must be given to the parents **every FRIDAY**.

Grading Policies:

- Assignments will be graded each morning at the start of class
- Grades will be broken down into DAILY WORK (50%) and TESTS & QUIZZES (50%)
- All work is considered late if not ready for grading each morning and will be deducted 20%. Written excuse notes or emails from a parent or guardian will be accepted on the day the assignment was due.
- All work and tests can be redone for an average of the two scores, but students must follow proper procedures.
 - Daily work – to redo an assignment the student must
 - Redo problems on a separate sheet of paper while showing work.
 - Students will have to grade redo assignments at lunch recess or after school.
 - Test – to redo a test students must
 - Come see the teacher to discuss their test.
 - Then must complete practice problems assigned by the teacher and grade them.
 - A redo test must then be scheduled.
