SYLLABUS

Bible Class

Instructional Goals

At the end of this course, you will:

- Learn about how Lucifer was created and caused mutiny in Heaven.
- Learn how man was created but had a fall in Eden and then rebelled and caused God to send a flood.
- Learn about the story of Job, how Abraham displayed great faith, the story of Isaac and Jacob, the giving of God's law on Sinai and the establishment of His sanctuary.
- Learn lessons from God's people in their cycles of apostasy, repentance, and reformation.
- Study aspects of the life of Christ from Bethlehem to Calvary and how the character of God was revealed in Jesus' life.
- Learn about God's infant church and how they grew at Pentecost, and how truth grew in the ages to follow, also how Satan tried to extinguish it but failed.
- Learn and apply the truths that were rediscovered during the reformation and learn about the reformers and their courage to stand for Jesus.
